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GENERAL

My figures are crocheted in continuous spiral rounds, unless stated otherwise.

The toys should be crocheted as tight as possible, so the stuffing does not shine through.

I regularly use yarn for hook size 3,5mm – 4mm and a hook size 2,5mm (C/D).

The colors and yarn in this pattern are just a suggestion. Of course you can use your favorite colors and yarn. That's why I usually don't indicate color numbers or manufacturers.

However: Please be aware not to mix different manufacturers. It is important to compare the strength and length of the used yarn. Example: Using a 200m/50g and a 130m/50g for one figure will lead to wrong proportions. I exclusively use synthetic yarn.

Size: 13 cm

MATERIAL

- Crochet hook size 2,5mm
- 2x half beads 12mm per bunny
- Fiberfill, craft glue, tapestry needle, scissors, white embroidery yarn (whiskers)
- Yarn ~130m/50g:

Bunny 1:

- Beige x1
- Sand x1

Bunny 2:

- Rosé x1
- Ecrú x1

Bunny 3:

- Grey x1
- Ecrú x1

Eyes and nose:

- White x1
- Peach x1

ABBREVIATIONS

- sc – single crochet
- ch – chain
- tch – turning chain
- ss – slip stitch
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- inc – increase – 2 sc in 1 stitch
- dec – decrease – sc2tog
- () – Brackets mean you have to repeat this action

Example: (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 means you have to repeat 3 times -> 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc
there are 12 stitches to crochet.





Body

Work with beige, rosé or grey yarn and stuff firmly.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 sc
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 sc
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 sc
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 24 sc
6. (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 30 sc
7. (4 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 36 sc
8. 36 sc = 36 sc
9. (5 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 42 sc
10. 42 sc = 42 sc
11. 42 sc = 42 sc
12. 42 sc = 42 sc
13. 42 sc = 42 sc
14. 42 sc = 42 sc
15. 42 sc = 42 sc
16. (5 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 36 sc
17. 36 sc = 36 sc




Belly

Work with sand or ecru yarn.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 SC
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 24 SC
6. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The belly will be sewn below round 12 of the body:



Nose

Work with peach yarn and stuff firmly.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. 12 SC = 12 SC
5. 12 SC = 12 SC
6. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The nose will be sewn at the upper space of the belly:



Eyes x2

Work with white yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. (3 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 15 SC
5. 15 sc = 15 SC
6. 15 sc = 15 SC
7. 15 sc = 15 SC
8. (3 sc, 1 dec) x3 = 12 SC
9. (1 dec) x6 = 6 SC
10. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The eyes will be attached above the nose:



Teeth

Work with white yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. 6 sc = 6 SC
4. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The teeth will be attached below the nose:



Feet x2

Work with sand or ecru yarn and stuff softly.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 SC
5. 18 sc = 18 SC
6. 18 sc = 18 SC
7. 18 sc = 18 SC
8. (1 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 12 SC
9. 12 sc = 12 SC
10. Close the egde with 6 sc.
11. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The feet will be closed with 6 sc along the edge:



Knot in a thread in the color of the body.

Make two loops around the toes, pull the thread tightly and weave in loose ends.



The finished feet will be sewn onto the lower body:



Hands x2

Work with beige, rosé or grey yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. 12 sc = 12 SC
5. 12 sc = 12 SC
6. (1 sc, 1 dec) x4 = 8 SC
7. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The hands will be sewn onto the sides of the body:



Tail

Work with sand or ecru yarn and stuff firmly.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 SC
5. 18 sc = 18 SC
6. 18 sc = 18 SC
7. (1 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 12 SC
8. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The tail will be sewn onto the lower back of the body:



Ears x2

Work with beige, rosé or grey yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
 2. 6 sc = 6 SC
 3. (2 sc, 1 inc) x2 = 8 SC
 4. (3 sc, 1 inc) x2 = 10 SC
 5. (4 sc, 1 inc) x2 = 12 SC
 6. (3 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 15 SC
 7. (4 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 18 SC
 8. 18 sc = 18 SC
- Work in rows:
9. 6 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 6 SC
 10. Skip 1 stitch, 12 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 12 SC



11. Skip 1 stitch, 10 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 10 SC
12. Skip 1 stitch, 8 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 8 SC
13. Skip 1 stitch, 6 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 6 SC
14. Skip 1 stitch, 4 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 4 SC
15. Skip 1 stitch, 2 sc = 2 SC



- Work in rounds:
16. Crochet evenly around with 18 sc = 18 SC
 17. (8 sc, 1 inc) x2 = 20 SC
 18. 20 sc = 20 SC

Ears inside x2

Work with sand or ecru yarn.

| 9. | 3 sc, 1 dec, 1 tch, to turn | = 4 SC |

- 10. 4 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 4 SC
- 11. 2 sc, 1 dec, 1 tch, to turn = 3 SC
- 12. 3 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 3 SC
- 13. 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 tch, to turn = 2 SC
- 14. 2 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 2 SC
- 15. 2 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 2 SC

At ear 1 continue with:

- 16. 2 sc = 2 SC
- 17. Crochet evenly around.
- 18. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

At ear 2 continue with:

- 16. 2 sc, 1 tch, to turn = 2 SC
- 17. Crochet evenly around.
- 18. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The inside of the ears will be sewn onto the ears:



The finished ears will be sewn onto the top of the body and closed at the tips with a few stitches.

Lead threads out of white embroidery yarn through the belly to make the whiskers.

The two 12mm half beads will be glued as pupils to finish the bunny.
