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# GENERAL

My figures are crocheted in continuous spiral rounds, unless stated otherwise.

The toys should be crocheted as tight as possible, so the stuffing does not shine through.

I regularly use yarn for hook size 3,5mm – 4mm and a hook size 2,5mm (C/D).

The colors and yarn in this pattern are just a suggestion. Of course you can use your favorite colors and yarn. That's why I usually don't indicate color numbers or manufacturers.

However: Please be aware not to mix different manufacturers. It is important to compare the strength and length of the used yarn. Example: Using a 200m/50g and a 130m/50g for one figure will lead to wrong proportions. I exclusively use synthetic yarn.

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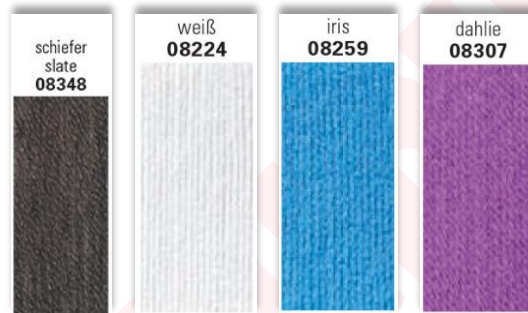

## MATERIAL

- Crochet hook size 2,5mm
- 2x half beads 8mm
- Fiberfill, craft glue, tapestry needle, scissors
- Yarn ~130m/50g:
  - Dark grey x1
  - White x1
  - Color of your choice x1 (I've used blue and purple)

## ABBREVIATIONS

- sc – single crochet
- ch – chain
- tch – turning chain
- ss – slip stitch
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- inc – increase – 2 sc in 1 stitch
- dec – decrease – sc2tog
- ( ) – Brackets mean you have to repeat this action

Example: (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 means you have to repeat 3 times -> 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc there are 12 stitches to crochet.

Work with dark grey yarn and stuff firmly.

6. (4 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 18 sc
7. (5 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 21 sc
8. (6 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 24 sc
9. (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 30 sc
10. 30 sc = 30 sc
11. 30 sc = 30 sc
12. 30 sc = 30 sc
13. 30 sc = 30 sc
14. 30 sc = 30 sc
15. 30 sc = 30 sc
16. (3 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 24 sc

## Body

Work with a color of your choice and dark grey yarn (color change) and stuff firmly.

With color of your choice:

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 sc
3. (1 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 9 sc
4. (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 12 sc
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x4 = 16 sc

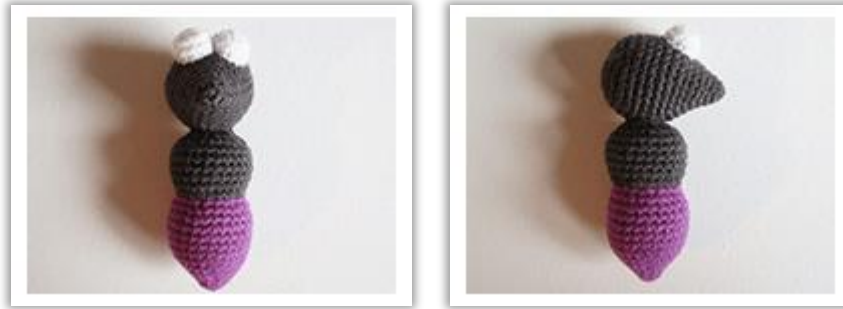


## Eyes x2

Work with white yarn and stuff softly.

5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 12 SC
6. 12 sc = 12 SC
7. (3 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 15 SC
8. 15 sc = 15 SC
9. (4 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 18 SC
10. 18 sc = 18 SC
11. (4 sc, 1 dec) x3 = 15 SC

## Wings - large x2

Work with white yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:

4. 9 sc = 9 SC
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 12 SC
6. 12 sc = 12 SC
7. (3 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 15 SC
8. 15 sc = 15 SC
9. (4 sc, 1 inc) x3 = 18 SC
10. 18 sc = 18 SC

The small wings will be sewn onto the lower back. The large wings will be sewn directly above them:



## Antennas x2

Work with dark grey yarn.

1. 8 ch, 1 tch, then along the chains: 8 ss.
2. Leave a thread for sewing.

The antennae will be sewn behind the eyes:



## Legs x6

Work with dark grey yarn.

1. 10 ch, 1 tch, then along the chains: 10 ss.
2. Leave a thread for sewing.

The legs will be sewn onto the sides of the body:



And the two 8mm half beads will be glued as pupils:
