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GENERAL

My figures are crocheted in continuous spiral rounds, unless stated otherwise.

The toys should be crocheted as tight as possible, so the stuffing does not shine through.

I regularly use yarn for hook size 3,5mm – 4mm and a hook size 2,5mm (C/D).

The colors and yarn in this pattern are just a suggestion. Of course you can use your favorite colors and yarn. That's why I usually don't indicate color numbers or manufacturers.

However: Please be aware not to mix different manufacturers. It is important to compare the strength and length of the used yarn. Example: Using a 200m/50g and a 130m/50g for one figure will lead to wrong proportions. I exclusively use synthetic yarn.

Size: 6 cm

MATERIAL

- Crochet hook size EU: 2,5mm – US: B/C
- Half beads 6 mm
- Wire, fiberfill, craft glue, tapestry needle, scissors
- Optional: Decoration for the cloverleaf, hangers for the pigs
- Yarn weight 3 light – 130m/50g:
 - Skin x1 (melba)
 - Darker skintone for nostrils x1 (peach)
 - White x1
 - Brown x1 (beige or wood)
 - Dark color for mud x1 (plum)
 - Light green x1

ABBREVIATIONS

- sc – single crochet
- ch – chain
- tch – turning chain
- ss – slip stitch
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- inc – increase – 2 sc in 1 stitch
- dec – decrease – sc2tog
- () – Brackets mean you have to repeat this action

Example: (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 means you have to repeat 3 times -> 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc
there are 12 stitches to crochet.

Tub

Work with brown yarn.

Leave a longer thread at the beginning!

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 SC
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 24 SC
6. (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 30 SC
7. (4 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 36 SC
8. (5 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 42 SC
9. (6 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 48 SC
10. (7 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 54 SC
11. (7 sc, 1 dec) x6 into the back loops only = 48 SC
12. 48 sc = 48 SC
13. (11 sc, 1 inc) x4 = 52 SC
14. 52 sc = 52 SC
15. (12 sc, 1 inc) x4 = 56 SC
16. 56 sc = 56 SC
17. (13 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 60 SC
18. 60 sc = 60 SC
19. 60 sc = 60 SC
20. 60 sc = 60 SC
21. (8 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 54 SC
22. 54 sc = 54 SC
23. (7 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 48 SC
24. 48 sc = 48 SC
25. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The top of the edge will be folded to the inside and sewn or glued at the bottom.

The long starting-thread will be led to the outside for sewing the mud later:



Bottom

Work with brown yarn.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 sc
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 sc
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 sc
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 24 sc
6. (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 30 sc
7. (4 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 36 sc
8. (5 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 42 sc
9. (6 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 48 sc
10. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The bottom will be sewn or glued into the tub. It's more stable now:



Mud

Work with plum yarn.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 sc
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 sc
4. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 sc
5. (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 24 sc
6. (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 30 sc
7. 30 sc = 30 sc
8. 30 sc = 30 sc
9. 30 sc = 30 sc
10. 30 sc = 30 sc
11. (2 sc, 1 inc) x10 into the back loops only = 40 sc
12. (3 sc, 1 inc) x10 = 50 sc
13. (4 sc, 1 inc) x10 = 60 sc
14. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The mud will be inserted into the tub and sewn onto the bottom of the tub to fix it.
The empty space inside will be stuffed with fiberfill and the mud will be sewn along the top of the tub.



Cloverleaf part x4

Work with light green yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. 12 sc = 12 SC
5. (4 sc, 1 dec) x2 = 10 SC
6. (3 sc, 1 dec) x2 = 8 SC
7. (2 sc, 1 dec) x2 = 6 SC
8. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

Stem

Work with light green yarn.

1. 6 ch, 1 tch, then along the chains:
2. 6 ss = 6 SS
3. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The four leaves will be sewn onto each other. The stem will be sewn between two of them.
If you wish, you can glue a decorative element at the middle (heart, ladybug, star, ...).



Pig

Body & head

Work with skin yarn and stuff firmly.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. (1 inc) x6 = 12 SC
4. 12 sc into the back loops only = 12 SC
5. 12 sc = 12 SC
6. (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 18 SC
7. (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 24 SC
8. 24 sc = 24 SC
9. (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 = 30 SC
10. 30 sc = 30 SC
11. 30 sc = 30 SC
12. 30 sc = 30 SC
13. 30 sc = 30 SC
14. 30 sc = 30 SC
15. (3 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 24 SC
16. (2 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 18 SC
17. (1 sc, 1 dec) x6 = 12 SC
18. (1 dec) x6 = 6 SC
19. Fasten off.



Eyes x2

Work with white yarn.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 6 sc = 6 SC
3. Finish with 1 ss. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The eyes will be sewn or glued directly above the nose:



Ears x2

Work with skin yarn and do not stuff.

1. 2 ch or „Magic Ring“, then:
2. 4 SC = 4 SC
3. (1 inc) x4 = 8 SC
4. 8 sc = 8 SC
5. (1 sc, 1 inc) x4 = 12 SC
6. 12 sc = 12 SC
7. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The ears will be sewn behind the eyes:



Tail

Work with skin yarn.

1. 10 ch, 1 tch, then along the chains:
2. 10 sc = 10 SC
3. Fasten off. Leave a thread for sewing.

The tail will be sewn onto the back:



The 6 mm half beads will be glued as pupils.
The nostrils are embroidered with darker skintone (peach) and a hanger is sewn onto the top:
